

How to implement redirects in Confirmit

Confirmit uses a simple JScript redirect function

```
Redirect(url,{noexit});
```

Parameters

url – is a string with the complete URL and it is mandatory.

noexit – is a Boolean. It is optional, and is used when you want the respondents to be able to reenter the survey, for example if you redirect out of the survey to another url, and then at some point the respondents are redirected back to the Confirmit survey again (with r (respid) and s (sid) or the encrypted __sid__).

This is especially important if the survey is set up without "Allow user to modify answers after the interview is complete". With noexit as true, the respondent will be allowed to reenter the survey. With noexit as false (default), the respondent will not be allowed reentry to the survey.

How to implement the redirect

At the end of the survey add a `script` block and copy paste the following code inside:

```
SetStatus("complete");
SetInterviewEnd();
Redirect("http://s.cint.com/Survey/Complete?ProjectToken=bd776941-eca2-42b7-8178-14c32ae65f55",false);
```

Please replace the above URL highlighted in blue with the redirect URL from Access.

Please do not use the URLs above, they are just an example.

Redirect is used in combination with SetStatus and SetInterviewEnd so that the respondent is given the correct status and end time stamp before being redirected out of the survey.

You will have to repeat the same steps for every screen out condition and for the quotas using the corresponding Access links provided.
